**THE DEAN OF DERBY** It has been announced that the Very Revd Dr Stephen Hance, Dean of Derby, has been invited to become National Lead for Evangelism and Witness for the Church of England, based at Church House Westminster. He will be responsible for the Church's goals around evangelism – to motivate the million Anglican churchgoers to share their faith, to equip a thousand new evangelists, and to enable clergy to lead evangelistic churches. His final Sunday here will be 1st September, and the Bishop of Derby will be with us for the 10.45am Eucharist. Bishop Libby will appoint an acting Dean in due course and begin the task of recruiting Stephen's successor.

Stephen says, "It has been a privilege to serve as Dean here for the last two years, and while I am moving on sooner than anticipated, I am grateful for all we have accomplished together., Please keep Jacqui and me in your prayers, as we will keep this Cathedral and Diocese in ours."
