CANDLEMAS AND CHRISTINGLE: The season of Epiphany ends with the Feast of the Presentation in the Temple on 2nd February, when the recognition of Jesus as 'a light for all nations' is traditionally celebrated as Candlemas. On Saturday 2nd February at 4.00 pm there will be a special Christingle service, led by students of Derby Cathedral School and sung by the children taking part in Be A Chorister for a Day that afternoon. This service marks the 50th anniversary of the Children's Society's association with Christingle. On Sunday 3rd February Evensong will be followed by a candlelit performance of Benjamin Britten's Ceremony of Carols, sung by the Girl Choristers.
