LENT, HOLY WEEK AND EASTER: a look ahead with some dates for the diary

'Bread of Life', the Bridge Chapel Lent Course, will meet in the Beddoes Room on Mondays from 2.30 – 4.00 pm, beginning on Monday 4th March (before Lent!), and will be looking at the Eucharist module of the Pilgrim Course.

Ash Wednesday, 6th March: Sung Eucharist with the imposition of ashes at 1.05 pm and at 6.30 pm. Ashes to Go will be available on Iron Gate.

'How to Live', the Lent sermon series, begins at the 6.30 pm service on Ash Wednesday with 'How to Hope', continuing on Sunday evenings in Lent at 6.00 pm with How to Love, How to Tell the Truth, How to Remember, How to Belong, and How to Die, with preachers including the Bishop of Repton, the Archdeacon of Derby, and the Revd Carla Vicencio Prior.

On Fridays in Lent at the Bridge Chapel there will be an **early morning Eucharist** at 7.00 am, beginning on Friday 8th March.

Palm Sunday, 14th April: the Blessing of the Palms is at 10.15 am with St Mary's Church, followed by a procession to the Cathedral for the Cathedral Eucharist at 10.45 with a dramatised reading of the Passion story. The Cathedral **Annual General Meeting** follows at 12.15 pm. On Palm Sunday evening at 6.00 pm there is a service of **Music and Readings for Passiontide**, with admissions to the Guild of King Edmund (the Cathedral volunteers' guild) and the first talk by our **Holy Week speaker**, Canon Christina Baxter, formerly Principal of St John's College Nottingham, a Reader and a distinguished New Testament scholar. She will be speaking on Palm Sunday evening, at Compline from Monday to Wednesday, on Maundy Thursday evening, and on Good Friday.

Holy Week services: on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday at 6.30 pm, there will be an address by Dr Baxter followed by sung **Compline**. On Maundy Thursday, 18th April, the Diocesan Chrism Eucharist is at 11.00 am and the Liturgy of the Last Supper at 6.30 pm. On **Good Friday**, 19th April, the Three Hours at the Cross begins at 12 noon with the Preaching of the Cross, followed by the Liturgy of the Passion from 1.30 pm until 3.00 pm. **Easter activities for children** are in the Beddoes Room on 19th April, 1.30 – 3.00 pm. **Easter Eve**, Saturday 20th April, is a day of quietness and waiting, with Morning Prayer at 8.30 pm and Evening Prayer at 5.15 pm, both in the Bridge Chapel.

Easter Day begins at dawn on Sunday 21st April with the **Easter Vigil** in the Bridge Chapel, starting at 4.30 am and moving to the Cathedral for the Kindling of the New Fire at 5.00 am and the **Easter Liturgy** with the Acting Bishop of Derby. Breakfast after the Easter Liturgy is in the Cathedral Café. Following breakfast, morning services are at the normal Sunday times. **Choral Evensong** on Easter Day is at the earlier time of 3.00 pm.
