PALM SUNDAY (14th April): the **Procession with Palms** will gather at the convent garden beside St Mary's Church to begin at 10.15 am, moving to the Cathedral for the Cathedral Eucharist at 10.45 am, with a dramatized reading of the Passion Gospel. The Bridge Chapel's 9.15 am Eucharist will be said, not sung, and will finish in time for people to join the Procession with Palms if they wish. At 6.00 pm there is a special service of **Music and Readings for Passiontide**, with the first address from the Holy Week preacher, Canon Dr Christina Baxter CBE.

HOLY WEEK and EASTER services are listed in a separate flyer available in the Cathedral. Set your alarm now for the Easter Vigil at dawn on Easter Day.
