THE VERY REVD DR STEPHEN HANCE, DEAN OF DERBY is leaving Derby to take up a new role as National Lead for Evangelism and Witness for the Church of England, based at Church House in Westminster. Today is the Dean's last Sunday at the Cathedral; he is preaching at the 10.45am Eucharist and officiating at Evensong. Bishop Libby is presiding at the Cathedral Eucharist this morning, and a presentation will be made to Stephen and Jacqui at the end of the service. Please keep them in your prayers as they say farewell to Derby Cathedral and during this time of transition.
