# Music at Derby Cathedral

## Providing inspiring music and worship

Derby Cathedral holds a rich and flourishing musical tradition. The Cathedral Choirs are at the heart of this, enhancing daily worship, and marking many significant liturgical moments and special services for City and County.

The Cathedral Choir consists of 40 choristers and Lay Clerks (adult professional singers), and has a renowned reputation for producing high quality choral music. There is also a Junior Choir for pre-chorister aged children, and a Voluntary Choir.

The choristers are given fantastic opportunities to perform in concerts, broadcasts, tours, and enjoy the social and wellbeing benefits of singing. The first-rate musical education they receive enhances their academic work and provides a solid foundation for the future.

Many former choristers go on to complete choral scholarships, read music at university, and develop careers in music.

## Music in Schools

Derby Cathedral's Music in Schools programme launched in September 2021. Those reached have been given access to school-based music and singing sessions delivered by one of our team of professional musicians, all of whom are trained choral specialists.

## Did you know?

**£2,000**

pays for a chorister for a year. This includes music theory, singing lessons, robes, uniform, subsidised tours & chorister pay.

**£320**

helps to provide singing lessons for a chorister for one year.

**£160**

could pay for a new set of robes for a chorister.

**£400**

could pay for a choral service, helping to provide inspiring music & worship.

**£1,500**

to deliver a weekly Music in Schools session to one school for a year, giving more children access to choral tuition.

**£40**

could pay for a singing lesson, helping to develop a chorister's musical talent.
