

Sinister goings-on at Derby Cathedral

Macbeth – Partners of Greatness

For release on September 18th 2025

This autumn, Derby Cathedral hosts a haunting and emotional adaptation of one of Shakespeare's most intense and terrifying plays.

Macbeth - Partners of Greatness - shines a light on the passionate relationship between the two central characters, while the rest of the play lurks in shadows.

Follow the fierce and fearsome couple - Macbeth and Lady Macbeth - as they slay their way to the top and struggle to stay there - from shared ambition to bloody hands, from guilty minds to total despair.

Derby-based 1623 theatre company celebrate their 20th anniversary by performing in the gothic magnificence of Derby Cathedral for the very first time.


Ben Spiller, artistic director of 1623, explains: "1623 is all about shaking, shaping and sharing creativity with communities and Shakespeare. We have co-created this version of Macbeth with communities across the UK, and we are delighted to be sharing it with people in our home city of Derby."

Local actors Oliver Tunstall and Lara de-Leuw are playing the central parts of Macbeth and Lady Macbeth in this thoughtful and moving take on the play.

Oliver says: "This is not a traditional production of Shakespeare's tragedy - we are sharing the story from the point of view of a couple who have lost their child. We really want to show how the Macbeths are lost in the fog of their grief."

Lara adds: "Yes, and how they make decisions in that fog, after not having had the support that they need to navigate their grief and make healthier choices. It's a very human story, one that we can all relate to - we want people to feel connected to the characters and care about them."

Laura Fraser, commercial manager at Derby Cathedral quotes: "We're thrilled to welcome this powerful production of Macbeth to Derby Cathedral. The Cathedral's



unique atmosphere offers a dramatic and unforgettable setting for live theatre, and we're proud to support events that bring people together through culture and creativity."

Macbeth - Partners of Greatness - plays at Derby Cathedral twice on Saturday October 25th. Performances start at 2.30pm and 7.30pm. The show runs at approximately one hour, with a post-show chat.

Both performances are captioned using the Difference Engine - a free app, which audience members can download and use on their smart phones.
